Theory:

- 1. Portion for Internal I, II & III is not mentioned in the syllabus.
- 2. No questions for 2 marks; fill up the blanks, assertion reason and sequential step, multiple choice questions for 1 marks were not included in many question papers.
- 3. Syllabus should be split into units with hours.
- Remedial classes for weak students and failure students is to be recorded and should duly signed by the students.
- 5. Minimum 2 assignments or one assignment with presentations is to be followed and according marks should have been allotted.
- 6. Few blue / yellow books were without PC & HoD's signature.
- 7. Most files, assignment part were not corrected and it can be indicated using red color ink pen / ball point pen.

Laboratory:

- 1. Experiments conducted should be mentioned in the list of experiments conducted. It may be revision also, and it should be mentioned.
- 2. For practicals courses, syllabus is to be enclosed in the file.
- 3. Lab hours can be increased for 3 hours.

Evaluation:

- 1. Total theory syllabus should be divided into 5 units and it can be give 5 course out (CO 5 or 6 for each theory paper).
- 2. Bloom's taxonomy will enrich the question paper.
- 3. CO 1 & CO 2 allotment basis is missing in all theory papers. Unless we split the total syllabus in to 2 units. CO 1 & CO 2 allotment is arbitrary.
