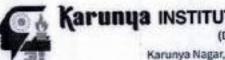

The academic auditor's comments were presented below:

The overall course file submission was done properly by the faculty of agriculture. However, there are some areas for improvement.

- The course outcome in a syllabus must have more than one which can be revised in the upcoming BOS.
- The attendance for classes which are cancelled due to University programmer or department activity must be entered in the attendance register online / blue book.
- Assignments must have application oriented approach rather than theoretical information, challenging assignments must be given to students
- Innovation in teaching can be introduced like flipped classroom one hour in a semester for a course to make teaching and learning process interesting
- In question paper 20% to 30% HOT (Higher Order Thinking) to be included rather than straight forward questions to meet the course outcome
- The blue and yellow register can be removed as online attendance entry is in practice. The course page can be made online.

- Albeit a few hiccups as specified below, the efforts put up by the faculty of the departments is well appreciated.
- 3. Course outcomes in a few cases did not match with the questions as it is evidenced in the internal as well as end semester question paper
- 4. In CO mapping, Fixing to achievable targets need not be mentioned in the final graph where there is a comparison of the target planned Vs Attained.
- 5. When a system is followed it is necessary to ensure that all the members involved adhere to the norms prescribed. Eg: Getting lab manual approved by the respective HoD is a mandate, in which slight deviations are observed.
- In Bioinformatics department, the Cumulative Course Outcome status report is not enclosed. This can be reinforced in the subsequent semesters
- The number of instruction hours to match with the credits of the course and if extra classes are handled substantial proof for the same be maintained separately or together with the attendance statement.
- 8. In quality assessment component, Assignments given to students be monitored adequately such that issues pertaining to plagiarism can be avoided. Redefining the assignment component to more student centric beneficial component can be thought of like giving them small surveys addressing issues of the society could be more practical and helpful for a holistic development.
- The Board of Studies can decide and evolve a common pattern for spelling out Course Objectives and Course Outcomes.
- 10. In a few cases Objectives are MIS SPELT as Course Outcomes which can be modified.
- 11. The Blue book and yellow book can be avoided as it is made online. This will reduce redundancy.
- 12. The entire faculty be adequately exposed to the Current trends in Outcome based education by way of a Faculty Development Program which shall enhance the effectiveness of the model.

Academic Audit for inspecting the course files of the subjects handled by the faculty members of Mathematics has been carried on 10.03.2018.

Comments:

- 1. The department presented 81 files related to the subjects handled in the last semester July 2017-Dec 2017.
- 2. The course preparation and the delivery process are very good and methodical.
- 3. It is found that special care is taken for the slow learners.
- 4. The remedial measure taken to conduct special supplementary examinations for those failed in the subjects is a strong step in the right direction.

Suggestions:

- 1. The CO target levels chosen by the faculty may be streamlined in to a common feasible and reasonable range (Eg: Any value between 50% 100%).
- 2. The content of the syllabus (14MA3018) including the topics of Operations Research may be extended by including two more topics, Transportation problems and Assignment Problems.
- 3. The presentation of the histogram/table giving the details of internal, final marks and CO attainment table together may give a picture of completeness in the teaching process through the remedial measures taken for the slow learners.
- 4. Provision may be made in the blue book and answer booklets to specify the degree and branch instead of branch alone.
- 5. In the assessment column (Form No.3)-Quality assurance may include "the remedial measures towards improving the outcome".

By and large this exercise will strengthen the academic structure and scope for improving the overall standard of the institute into a new height.
