The Hon'ble Prime Minister's green and healthy environment development's initiative "one student, one tree" programme was started by the Minister of the Central Human Resource Development (MHRD) recently. Following the instructions of All India Council for Technical Education [AICTE] and guidance of Chancellor Dr. Paul Dhinakaran, Karunya Deemed to be University the students of the National Service Scheme along with NCC planted Tree Saplings in Mathvarayapuram on the Independence Day.



- 5) **RELIEF CAMP FOR THE OOTY PEOPLE AFFECTED IN THE INCESSANT RAIN:** On Independence Day (15th August 2019), Karunya's National Service Scheme and SEESHA Charitable Trust jointly distributed basic needs in the relief camp located in Indira Nagar near Emerald, Ooty, Tamil Nadu which was recently affected by the incessant rain. - 6) **73rd INDEPENDENCE DAY CEREMONY:** The 73rd Independence Day ceremony was held at 7.30 a.m. at Karunya Deemed to be University, Coimbatore. The Vice

Chancellor Dr. P. MannarJawahar hoisted the flag and delivered the keynote address and accepted the parade of the National Cadet Corps, DGS Rovers Crew and the National Services Scheme students. To portray the country's unity colourful cultural and heritage programs were performed by the students. The Pro Vice Chancellor Dr. E.J. James, the Registrar Dr. Elijah Blessing, professors and students participated in the ceremony.

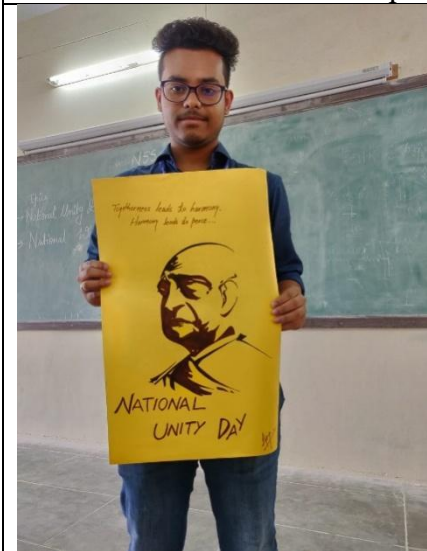

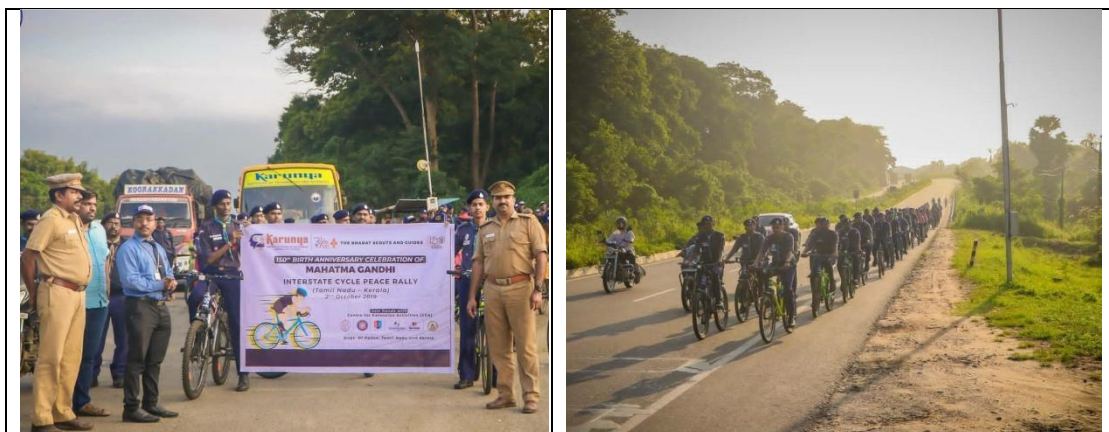
The following activities were organized:

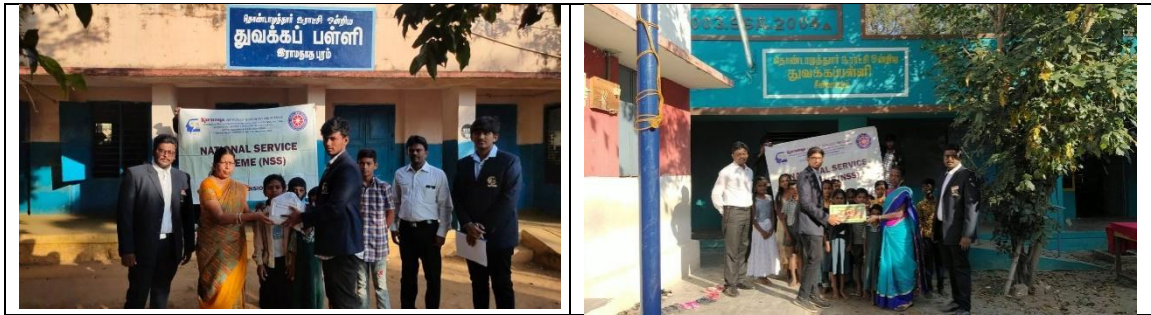
